Jeannette E. South-Paul, MD, FAAFP joined the Department of Family Medicine at the University of Pittsburgh in July 2001, and is the Andrew W. Mathieson University of Pittsburgh Medical Center Professor of Family Medicine in April of 2005.

Dr. South-Paul is an active teacher in the classroom, in the ambulatory health center, and at the bedside. She has been recognized nationally as a champion of cultural competence training for health care trainees, practicing clinicians, and faculty. She teaches this material to practitioners of a variety of disciplines and levels of experience. Her current research interests in health disparities build upon her clinical efforts to meet the needs of the underserved communities in Pittsburgh. She maintains an active family medicine practice to include maternity care at the UPMC Matilda Theiss Clinic. Dr. South-Paul currently serves on multiple executive committees and boards.

Dr. South-Paul is a graduate of the University of Pennsylvania and was awarded a M.D. from the University of Pittsburgh School of Medicine She completed an internship and residency in family practice in 1982 at the Eisenhower Army Medical Center, Ft. Gordon, GA. In 1984, she completed a Family Medicine Faculty Development Fellowship at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill.

She is an immediate Past President of the Society of Teachers of Family Medicine was selected as a McCann Scholar for mentoring in 2004. She received an AMA Pride in the Profession award in February 2007.
